10 - 50 mg/dl	Subclinical
30 - 120 mg/dl	Euphoria
90 - 250 mg/dl	Excitement
180 - 300 mg/dl	Confusion
250 - 400 mg/dl	Stupor
350 - 500 mg/dl	Coma

Use

- Detection of ethanol (alcohol) in blood to confirm prior consumption or administration of ethanol.
- Quantification of ethanol concentration in blood correlates directly with degree of intoxication.
- Diagnosis of Chronic alcoholism - such individuals will require higher levels than indicated above to achieve various states of intoxication.
