
Comment**Interpretation :-**

1. **Faecal Immunochemical Tests (FIT)** aids in the diagnosis of “lower GI pathologies” such as “Colorectal cancers” and “adenomas that bleed.
2. It detects following in stool sample :
 - a. Human Hemoglobin
 - b. Hemoglobin/haptoglobin complex
3. **NORMAL RESULT MEANS.....** the test did not detect any blood in the stool. However, because cancers in the colon may not always bleed, one may need to do the test a few times to confirm that there is no blood in the stool.
4. **ABNORMAL RESULT MEANS** There is blood in the stool, and that other tests like colonoscopy /Sigmoidoscopy should be advised. The FIT test **does not diagnose cancer by itself**, it indicates the need to further perform other screening tests such as a sigmoidoscopy or colonoscopy
5. Thus Both the FIT and other screening tests can catch colon cancer early.....
6. **Advantages over routine stool occult blood test**
 - a. Fewer false positive results.
 - b. No interference with medicine and food.
 - c. Specificity is very high (86 – 98%)
